MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING: NURSING LEADERSHIP, INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE TRACK

Integrated Healthcare Track: This track supports students to meet their career goals and can be customized with a total of 3 electives in varied concentrations and a one semester practicum. Electives in areas of management, education, palliative care and informatics are some of the options. Both the Clinical Systems and Integrated Healthcare track has the same number of total credits. STUDENTS DECIDE ON THE TRACK OF THEIR CHOICE **AFTER** COMPETING THE CORE COURSES AND IN COLLABORAITON WITH THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR.

Students are able to choose a concentration in Informatics Nursing within the Integrated Healthcare track of the MSN Nursing Leadership program. Students in this concentration would complete nine credits of coursework in Informatics Nursing and a four-credit clinical practicum in Informatics Nursing.
